Since the goal is to get patients back to their homes as quickly as possible, family members are given opportunities to participate in the patient's rehabilitation. Loved ones also take part in counseling and training to help them provide ongoing care.

We can also assist in identifying financial resources, support groups and other community resources.

The Center is accredited through the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. The program has served the Phoenix metropolitan area since 1983.

We serve individuals with conditions such as amputations, Multiple Sclerosis, Muscular Dystrophy, orthopedic trauma, Parkinson's disease, polyneuropathy, spinal cord or brain injury, major multiple trauma, rheumatoid arthritis, and stroke.
