

## Referral Chart by Domain

Domain	Red Flags	Specialist
<b>Hearing</b>	Quiet Infant Poor localization Limited startle to loud noises Frequent ear infections	 Audiologist  ENT
<b>Vision</b>	Poor tracking Improved alertness and engagement when faces/objects are closer Bumps into things, misses grasp Limited mobility	 Ophthalmologist that specializes in pediatrics
<b>Motor</b>	Limited mobility for age, late milestones Minimal movement of one side of body Limited ability to use utensils or play with age appropriate toys Poor quality of movement ( gestures, chewing, grasping)	 Occupational and/or Physical Therapist
<b>Sensory Integration</b>	Poor ability to regulate emotions Over or under sensitivity in any of the sensory areas Seeks out sensory input ( atypical): example- jumping from high places continuously with limited interest in other toys	 Occupational Therapy- specializing in Sensory Integration Dysfunction  Diagnostic Center
<b>Cognition</b>	Significantly delayed language and play skills for age History of abusive, neglect, addiction at birth Prematurity	 Team Assessment including developmental pediatrician ( if possible)  Diagnostic Center
<b>Behavior</b>	Significant tantrums –long in duration, unable to self-calm, physical ( aggression, destructive, self-abusive) Poor sleeper- up several times a night History of mental health difficulties in family Family Dynamic and response to child’s behavior (caregiver attends to negative behavior only, caregiver seems threatening , sense ‘end of rope’ , safety of others in question)	 Discuss with PCP  Psychologist with pediatric specialty  Diagnostic Center  Occupational Therapy ( sensory integration disorder)
<b>Medical Concerns</b>	Multiple organ involvement ( i.e. cardio, hearing)- could be genetic etiology Constipation ( chronic), Respiration ( chronic)- could be feeding issue Ear Infections ( chronic) Large tonsils/adenoids- poor sleeper, mouth breather, sleep apnea, drooling	 Discuss with PCP  Genetics  ENT  Feeding Team ( if available)  Gastroenterologist
