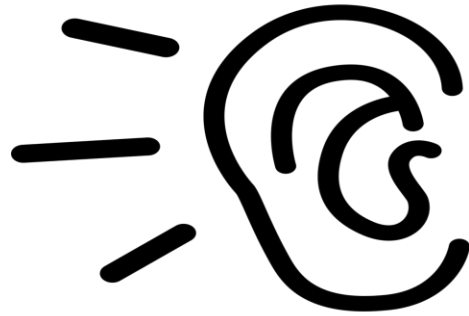


Name vs. Sound Rule



IN ONE SYLLABLE WORDS...

If the vowel says its **SOUND** (short sound)
... it requires MORE consonants

(2-3 consonant letters – dge, -ck, -tch)

If the vowel says its **NAME** (long sound)

OR there are two WRITTEN vowels (*TVGW rule)...

it requires LESS consonants

1-2 consonants – ge, -k, -ch)

<u>dge or ge?</u>		<u>ck or k?</u>		<u>tch or ch?</u>
