<p><b>Who is the smelliest fairy?</b> Stinkerbell (add /s/ in front of /t/ in "Tinkerbell")</p>	<p><b>When do astronauts get hungry?</b> At launch time (substitute /au/ for /u/ in "lunch")</p>
<p><b>Why did the chicken cross the playground?</b> To get to the other slide (add /l/ after /s/ in "side")</p>	<p><b>What do witches put on their bagels?</b> Scream cheese (add /s/ in front of /k/ in "cream")</p>
<p><b>Why does Dracula brush his teeth five times a day?</b> Because he has "bat" breath (substitute /t/ for /d/ in "bad")</p>	<p><b>What kind of clothing do clouds wear?</b> Thunderwear (add /th/ in front of /u/ in "under")</p>
<p><b>What kind of clothing do ghosts wear?</b> Boo-jeans (delete /l/ in "blue")</p>	<p><b>Where do dogs drive their car?</b> On the flea way (substitute /l/ for /r/ in "free")</p>
<p><b>What do you call a fat pumpkin?</b> A plumpkin (add /l/ after /p/ in "pump")</p>	<p><b>How do you make a witch itch?</b> Take away the "w" (delete /w/ in "witch")</p>
<p><b>What do you get if you cross a rabbit and a frog?</b> A bunny ribbit (substitute /i/ for /a/ in "rabbit")</p>	<p><b>What do you call an alligator who robs the bank?</b> A crocodile (substitute /oo/ for /o/ in "crocodile")</p>
